LOCKSETS & HANDLES

Tried, tested and proven, our Staff Override System (SOS) locksets are **anti-ligature and anti-barricade** to keep service users safer. They're intuitive to use, making life easier for staff and ensuring **fast access** – especially in stressful situations. Plus they're **robust** and ideal for retrofitting, keeping maintenance and installation costs to a minimum.

Customers tell us that while barricades are rare, they must be confident of gaining access quickly. That's why we developed the most complete override locking system on an anti-ligature lockset – our **5-way SOS (Staff Override System)**.

In the most common barricade scenario, the staff key dominates the internal turn/pull (key override), ending the barricade quickly and simply – with the backup of additional override methods to **ensure staff always get in**. We hope you never need it, however, when the moment comes and it helps you overcome determined tampering or manipulation from a service user, it might just save a life.



ELECTRONIC



Specifically designed for Mental Health environments, this is the only electronic lockset with **5-way SOS (Staff Override System)**. Battery-operated, it uses a harmless access card or key fob for day-to-day access. Service users therefore can be given control over their living space, helping them **regain confidence and dignity** while **reducing demand** on staff. The lack of a physical keyway also reduces the risk of tampering – minimising the need to use the emergency override.



MECHANICAL

Our mechanical locks have been used in Mental Health units for more than a decade, and improved along the way. Our standard model comes with 5-way SOS (Staff Override System), while 1-way SOS locksets are suitable for staff-only areas, where the tampering risk from service users is low.





Our patented 'no gap' pivot system successfully addresses the ligature issue, and solves many other problems. Because it opens easily both inwards and outwards, it's also **anti-barricade** without even having to think about it. Plus, with the right finish, it's **invisible**, **non-clinical** and easy to maintain. And, most importantly, it meets the highest possible safety standards, so it's fire rated for single leafs up to 1100mm, and is the only anti-ligature anti-barricade hinge to be FD60 rated.

Its unrivalled safety is ideal for the field of Mental Health, with tough extra-length pivot straps and fire resistant design protecting both door and service user.

Averting access to fixtures and details like anti-ligature washers helps reduce the risk of self-harm, while the double-swing action prevents the blocking of access to a room. **On-site height adjustment** is simple and quick to carry out. And the curved design and timber effect finishes are **aesthetically pleasing** and less institutional than continuous hinges.


DOOR CLOSER OPTIONS

Our choice of bedroom and communal door closers accounts for fire and staff safety, maintenance costs, and service user comfort and monitoring. After all, a bedroom is the service user's only personal space – so it needs to be special.

STANDARD

Automatic mechanical closer which maintains fire compartments and ensures staff safety

When the door is opened, it will self-close when released. With an adjustable power rating, the opening force can be specifically set for the size and weight of the door, ensuring they close and latch correctly – eliminating the annoying slam caused by non-adjustable closers. Plus the back check internal brake prevents the door being slammed or weaponised – improving safety and minimising maintenance.



FREESWING

No opening force, ideal for leaving doors open for observation

With no closing force, our Freeswing closer is less institutional, operating like a normal door at home. This also means that bedroom doors can be left ajar for better observation, removing the temptation to prop them open and put fire safety at risk. It's also easy to use by service users with reduced strength. Plus the closer is linked to the fire alarm, ensuring the door self-closes when needed.



HOLD-OPEN

Doors stay in the open position day to day, ideal for creating open, spacious environments

The concealed hold-open (EMAG) closer safely keeps door open – allowing easy movement through a building, reducing barriers and promoting independence. Surface mounted options are often prone to abuse and can look institutional, so our fully concealed unit is ideal for abusive environments and where designers want spaces to feel more normalised. Plus it's linked to the fire alarm, automatically closing to maintain fire compartments.





CASE STUDIES

HELLINGLY CENTRE, SUSSEX PARTNERSHIP NHS TRUST

The Hellingly Centre had significant problems with floor sprung door closers fitted during a previous project. They were therefore keen to find a door closer specifically designed for the challenging Mental Health environment. Our concealed transom door closer (Sureclose) provided the answer.

Sussex Partnership approached us after a ward refurbishment caused them significant issues with floor springs. Doors were either slamming or not shutting fully, creating both a security risk and unnecessary distress among service users.

To ensure they got a closer that worked first time, we recommended Sureclose. Fitted to the frame head, and with an adjustable power rating and closing speeds, it's the ultimate concealed door closer. After carrying out Department of Health medium secure abuse tests and browsing our online test database, Sussex Partnership were confident it was the right solution too.

To meet their needs, they used our standard mechanical closer on bedroom doors for **self-closing at a controlled speed**. On corridor doors, they chose our electro-magnetic (EMAG) hold-open option, which created more open spaces while maintaining fire compartments. The result? Safe and robust door closers that **enhanced security** and ensured a **peaceful ward environment**.

When this new CAMHS facility was looking for a single door closer system for multiple uses, they chose our concealed transom door closer. We installed the freeswing closer option on bedroom doors, and EMAG hold-open and standard mechanical closers elsewhere on the project – providing the best of both worlds for every type of door without compromising on safety.

When NHS Tayside built this new 12-bed unit, detail was everything. So as well as offering the ultimate in safety, the door closers had to feel homely and let service users decide whether to keep rooms open or shut, and still allow staff easy access and observation.

Our concealed overhead freeswing door closer ticked every box — and more. With no closing force during day-to-day use, it behaves just like a domestic door, so assists with normalisation. It also gives service users and staff the choice of keeping the door open. Yet it automatically self-closes in the event of an alarm, ensuring fire compartments are maintained. Plus the back check function provides an internal braking mechanism, **minimising potential abuse** that could damage the door.

As well as being easy to install, it's the only freeswing door closer that's **anti-ligature** and **anti-barricade** too. So when it comes to safety and performance, it provided peace of mind on every front.

Our retrofit anti-barricade doorstop combines durability and safety with a non-institutional aesthetic. Compatible with pivot or continuous hinge systems, its unique rapid release mechanism means doors can be opened outwards by staff at any time within just 15 seconds. 

Securely parking stations are fitted beside each door on the corridor wall. Staff can remove and park the stop in under 15 seconds. Once the incident is over, the staff key allows the stop to be reinstated for normal use.



Fire tested and certified, providing just one key for both observations and anti-barricade access, making it simple, quick and easy for staff to use.

Depending on use, the panel is available in it supports two robust thicknesses — 26mm (LSU/MSU) and 35mm (MSU/HSU). And it all comes with Vistamatic's lifetime guarantee.


